Purpose

The Tyrone Love SCHOLARSHIP FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE & ENGAGEMENT is given in memorial of Tyrone Love, a Garfield High School Graduate and Community Servant. The scholarship seeks to help African American Students who have a demonstrated track record of community service, pursue their dreams of higher education and is presented by 100 Black Parents.

Tyrone Love was MURDERED on Monday, February 16th, 2009. Tyrone was known throughout the greater Seattle area as promoter w/ VIBRANT ENT 206. He was known in and around the Central Area as a peaceful leader who was engaged with young people in many ways, including his job at the YMCA and his work at Seaspot Media Group. While at Garfield High School, Tyrone was known as responsible, fun loving student, who took pride in serving he fellow students, his community, and his family.



History

100 Black Parents was established in 2016 and is a program of Service is a Lifestyle (SIAL). SIAL is a 501(c)3 Non-Profit organization that is seeking to impact the community through programs that inspire service on a daily basis. In addition to our \$1,000 Tyrone Love scholarship we award annually, our organization engages students at Garfield High School and beyond by donating money in the form of micro grants, helping to recruit and retain parents and volunteers for school programs such as the Report Card Conference. 100 Black Parents also produces several events per year including the much beloved Bubblin Brown Sugar, The African American Males Weekend, and more.

Applicants for the Scholarship must:

- Be an African American Student at Garfield High School during the 2023-24 School Year
- Be a graduating high school student
- Complete the application process
- Have demonstrate involvement in community service
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Have demonstrated leadership skills and academic achievement

REQUIREMENTS

The following items must be included with each completed application:

- A completed **Scholarship Application**.
- An **official school transcript(s)**, indicating current GPA, courses taken and grades received. **** COPIES ARE OK ****
- **Two letters of reference (Non-Relative)**, one from an organization where the applicant is involved in community service and one from a School Administrator. ****Note these References can be from other applications and do not need to be specific to this scholarship ****
- A one-page (500 Words minimum) **personal statement** on your community involvement and/or engagement during your time at **Garfield High School** and any reasons why you think you should be selected to receive the Scholarship.

Please Note: Before funds are dispersed, recipient(s) must be officially enrolled at a university or college and attending classes. Each recipient will be required to provide proof of enrollment from their respective colleges.
